## **Graduation Requirements**

Divine Child High School's curriculum is designed to meet the needs and interests of each student. A total of 26.5 units of credit are required for graduation. Students must complete these units of credit in these subject areas:

- Theology = 4 years
- English = 4 years
- Mathematics = 4 years
- Science = 3 years (one year each of Biology and Chemistry, and one additional course)
- Social Studies = 3 years (World History, American History, Economics and American Government)
- World Languages = 2 consecutive years of the same language
- Physical Education = 1 year (one semester of Health, and one semester of Physical Education\*)
- Computer Literacy = .5 unit of credit or one semester
- Applied/Fine/Performing Arts = 1 year (either 1 year of F/P Arts, or one semester of F/P Arts and one semester of Applied Arts)
- Online Learning = .25 unit of credit (Summer courses permitted as are DC Test Prep courses)
- Electives = 3.25 units of credit

\* Students who enroll in Marching Band for two years fulfill the Physical Education requirement.
