Falcon Athletic Club Sport Team Representatives

What are Sport Team Representatives?:

In order to execute our mission, the Falcon Athletic Club identifies sport team representatives (STRs) from parents from each Varsity athletic team to represent their player's team to the Falcon Athletic Club. These volunteers are vital to our success and an integral part of the newly formed Falcon Athletic Club. The Sport Team Representative responsibilities are listed below.

Varsity Head Coaches are responsible to assign a FAC Sport Team Representative no later than a week after the Team/Parent Kick-off meeting held at the beginning of their particular season (Fall, Winter and Spring). Depending on the sport, it may make sense to designate a Co-Team Representative to make sure that everything is covered. Head Coaches for Winter and Spring sports can assign a FAC Sport Team Representative as soon as one is known as it's to their advantage to do so. The Sport Team Representative must be a member in good standing with the FAC. If a Head Coach chooses to not assign a STR, the coach will assume that responsibility.

Responsibilities include:

- **Membership** – actively recruit parents to join the FAC and encourage more involvement of the parents of all student-athletes including Fans.
- **Communication** – act as an information conduit of the FAC to the parents of your team and your head coach.
- **Represent** – attend the General Membership meetings of the Falcon Athletic Club. If you are unable to attend you must send a representative, preferably another team parent.
- **Present** – any particular needs, including monetary Grant Requests your team may have to the FAC. Team Reps may cast a single vote per matter of business.

- Volunteers for Events - organize team parent volunteers to help with FAC fundraising events. The FAC conducts a minimum of three significant fundraising events per school year. Two examples would include the Annual Golf Outing and Big Event.

Other Duties:

- Be a sounding board back to the Falcon Athletic Club and act as an ambassador for DC's sports program in general and for the FAC.
- Assist with and help plan the season ending banquet for your sport and any other special events that are team specific like Senior Nights, etc.
- Conduct succession planning for the team representative(s). A representative's new term begins after the sport season ends, example - football is played in the Fall, so if the team rep has a senior player, that rep needs to recruit a new representative to start in the Winter, subject to approval by the head coach.
- Provide news stories and photographs of their teams to be posted on the Falcon Athletic Club's webpage on the DCHS website and Facebook page.
